Children's Message: Church Calendar Epiphany


How do you remember when you are born every year?

There are 5 Seasons

Advent - 4 weeks before Christmas

Christmas - Christmas Day until the First Sunday after Epiphany (January 6th)

Ordinary Time - Which means counted or "ordered" time between the other seasons.

Lent - 50 Days before Easter (excluding the Sundays)

Easter - From Easter Sunday until Pentecost (50 days after Easter)

We gather weekly on Sunday to remind ourselves that God loves us.

That is why we sing and pray and learn and think.

There are truths tend to forget and take for granted.

The Church as Prophet



False Churches

Complacency (Health & Wealth)

- Unreflective, non-critical in thought, reinforces the status quo.

Condemnation (Westboro Baptist)

- Critical in spirit but not in mind, demonizes people.

Power Over Others

- Grows own power and influence over others to control.

True Churches

Compassion

- There is true love and affection which leads to truth-telling.

Conviction

- draws people towards Christ's person and forgiveness
- repentance and transformation.

Friendship - that brings freedom from darkness and sin. Freedom from evil within an without.

Individuals as Prophets



Trust God

The individual relationship with God must be a trusting and growing one.

Much like the character of Jeremiah

Humble

No one should ever assume they are a prophet as this can be a cause of egomania and delusion.

Condemnation or Complacency vs. Compassion & Conviction

Obedience & Courage to carry out their role.

Must continue to follow the aspects of Grace & Truth.

The truth is spoken in love, not compulsion.

It is a trained gift & role.

In Community

A Individual prophet must be embedded in a healthy stable discerning community and have directors Identified as prophets by community.

Accountability.

Our church has directions for prophets with the specific prophetic gifts

(visions, dreams, knowledge, interpretation of tongues)

Trust God - This is not to harm you or someone else.

Be Courageous - risk being wrong and speak up.

Discernment with pastors/elders - Get backup so you can confirm.

Be Obedent - deliver the message personally or by a wise means - the result is not yours to contol.

Be Free
